in hand well and truly paid by the said South Carolina Savings Bank, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina Savings Bank, of Greenville, S. C. its successors and assigns:

All those fifteen certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near Piney Mountain, on Blairmont Drive, and being a part of the lands known as Piney Mountain Park, and being described on a plat by metes and bounds made by Brodie and Bedell, Engineers Aug. 30th, 1915, and being known and designated as Lots nos. 119, 120, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129, 130, 131, 132, and 133, according to the plat hereinabove referred to, together with that certain parcel or strip of land situate as above between the Greenville, Spartanburg, and Anderson railways (Piedmont and Northern) and the Southern Railway, beginning at a point in a straight line of Lot #119 and running in a Westerly direction to the Stone line; this boundary is intended to cover all the land between the two said railways.
