until paid in full all interest not paid when due to be principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount due by said note... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of  
ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note..., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..., reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All my interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Spriggs Creek and lying on both sides of the Greenville and Hendersonville Highway, containing 74 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of George Finlay, L. S. Boswell and others, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning in the middle of the bridge where the old Buncombe Road crosses Spriggs Creek and running thence along said Buncombe road in an easterly direction about 15 chs to Allen's line; thence with his line N. 65° E. about 9 chs. to a stone 3x11 in place of chestnut 3x0 gone; thence S. 26 3/4° E. 8.92 chs to a red oak 3x0 m; thence S 77 1/2° E. 16.70 chs to a stone 3x0 m on Allen's corner; thence along Casone line S. 40° E. 9.45 chs to a stone 3x11 m in place of chestnut gone; thence N 84 3/4° E. 19.65 chs to a stone 3x0; thence N. 5 1/2° E. 11.40 chs to a stone 3x0; thence N. 5 1/2° E. 11.40 chs. to a stone 3x; thence down the branch as a line following the meanders thereof 25 chs. to a willow 3x11 m at mouth of small drain or branch; thence continuing down the first mentioned branch, following the meanders thereof as the line where it comes into confluence with Spriggs Creek; thence down said creek as the line to the beginning corner.
