Carpenter, in and by my certain promissory notes in writing of even date with these presents am well, and truly indebted to The Geer Drug Company, a corporation in the sum of just under of Seven Thousand Ninety-two and 77/100 (\$792.77). Obligations to be paid as follows: \$35.00 on the 25th day of April 1934 and \$35.00 on the 25th day of April and every month thereafter for twenty-one months, and \$32.77 on the twenty-second month from date thereof until the full and just sum of \$792.77 is paid in full. In the event any note is not paid at maturity, then all of said notes shall become immediately due and payable, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7% per annum, to be computed and paid as set forth in notes which the mortgage recites until paid in full, all interest not paid when due, together with interest at same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten dollars, besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note shall be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said note or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

All that lot of land on the East side of Brown Street and north of North Street, in the City of Greenville S.C. being a portion of the lot conveyed to J. H. Morgan and B. A. Morgan by L. C. Poling, see R. M. C. deed book 000 at page 678, and being a portion of the same lot of land conveyed to A. B. Carpenter by J. H. Morgan and B. A. Morgan see R. M. C. deed book 5 at page 161, and which is more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of lot formerly owned by W. G. Serrine (which said Serrine lot is the southern portion of the entire lot originally conveyed by said J. H. Morgan and B. A. Morgan to A. B. Carpenter) and running thence in an eastern direction along the line of the Serrine lot 157 feet to an iron pin corner of lot of J. F. Hodges; thence with the Hodges line 67 feet, more or less, to an Alley (known as Oak Street); thence with said alley about 161 feet to Brown Street, thence along Brown Street 37 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

This lot is the northern portion of the lot referred to in deed book 5, at page 161, the southern portion having been conveyed to W. G. Serrine by A. B. Carpenter, see deed book 10, at page 130. And this also being the same lot of land inherited by T. G. Carpenter from his father A. B. Carpenter deceased, who died intestate, leaving said T. G. Carpenter his son, his sole heir-at-law and distributee.
