SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *J. G. Hawkinson*

in and by *my* certain *deceased wife* note in writing, of even date with
these presents *Clara Davis* well and truly indebted to *People's National Bank, as guardian for the
Minor Children of W. H. Valentine, deceased* in the full and just sum of *\$150.00* (\$150.00) Dollars
to be paid: *one year after date*

with interest thereon from *Date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10 per cent*, besides all costs and expenses of collection,

to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said *Mortgagor* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Mortgagee* according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said *Mortgagor* in hand well and truly paid by the said *Mortgagee*, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said *Mortgagee*, and

Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in *Greenville County, State aforesaid*,

People's National Bank, as guardian for the Minor Children of W. H. Valentine, deceased

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Duncan Road* in *Greenville County, State of South Carolina*, and containing the following corner and dimensions to wit:

Beginning at a stone in the *White Horse Road*, west to *Tom Martin's land*, and run thence *S. 84 1/4 E. 16.80*, crossing cedar land road to a stone in the *Duncan Road*; thence along the center of said road *W. 34 E. 11.50*, crossing a branch to a stone in said road, next to *Frank Martin's land*; thence along said Martin land, *W. 84 1/4 W. 20.10* crossing the cedar lane road to a stone in the *White Horse Road*; thence along the center of said road *S. 18 W. 10.00* to the beginning corner, and containing *17.80* acres, more or less, a *quarter* of *W. A. Hester, Surveyor*, dated August 11, 1924. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me, by *J. G. Hawkinson* by deed dated February 21, 1925, recorded in office of *W. M. C. for Greenville County* in *Vol. 96*, page *378*.

Also *lot 2*, piece, parcel or lot of land in *Pine Mountain Townships and Greenville County, State of South Carolina*, and described as follows: Beginning at a stone near the junction of the *White Horse* and *Duncan Roads*, and run thence *S. 84 1/4 E. 10.70* to an iron pin; thence *W. 3 1/4 E. 11.90* to an iron pin; thence *W. 84 1/4 W. 6.80* to center of *White Horse Road*; thence along the *White Horse Road*, *12.40* to the beginning corner, containing *one and one-half (9 1/2)* acres, more or less, and being tract #2 according to the *W. A. Hester survey*, being a part of the lands owned by *Julia R. Hawkinson*, the mother of the *Mortgagor*, at the time of her death and inherited by her three children, to-wit: *Clara Davis, E. H. Hawkinson and J. G. Hawkinson*; and *Clara Davis* and *E. H. Hawkinson* having conveyed their interest in said tract to *J. G. Hawkinson* by deed dated April 2, 1922 and recorded in *W. M. C. office for Greenville County* in *Deed Book 65*, at page *240*.
