successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"As that certain lot of land situate, lying and being near the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, near the Greenville Highway and on the East side of 11th Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 70, of "Green Grove Park", so shown by a subdivision and plat of same made by J. E. Walton, Engineer, in May, 1924, said plat being of record in the Office of Greenville County Plat Book I, page 233, and having the following lines and boundaries and corners and distances, as shown by said plat, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of 11th Street, joint corner of Lot 69 and 70 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 69 S. 74° 17' E. 150 feet to a point in joint rear line of Lots 46 and 45; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 45 S. 15° 48' W. 80 feet to joint rear corner of Lot 44 and 71; thence along the line of Lot No. 71 N. 74° 12' W. 150 feet to an iron pin in line of 11th Street; thence along the line of said Ave. N. 18° 49' E. 50 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to the Horn Building Company"
