on the south side of Hill Crest Drive, near the City of Greenville, and known and delineated as Lots #15 of Block "A" of Highland Terrace, a subdivision as aforesaid on plat made by G.W. Peltzer, C. E. August 1917, recorded in Plat Book "E" at page No. 1, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Begging at an iron post on the south side of Hill Crest Drive, at point corner of lots #14 and #16, and running thence along the front of said lots #14 and #16 to an iron post 50 feet to an iron post on the south side of Hill Crest Drive, thence along south side of Hill Crest Drive 50 feet to the beginning corner.
