

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that certain tract of land containing Two Hundred Twenty-seven and Forty-seven hundredths (227.47) acres, more or less, known as the Jones Place in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the Fork Shoals and Augusta Public Roads, five miles Southwest from Greenville on the Waters of Reedy River and now in the possession of Ansel R. Meadors, bounded on the North by lands of Aug. W. Smith and Julia D. Charles, on the East by Reedy River; on the South by lands of J. R. Henderson, W. J. Long and Conmestee Mills, on the West by Fork Shoals and Augusta Roads. Said tract of land is more particularly described according to a plat there of prepared by W. J.
