All that certain tract of land containing Twenty-seven and twenty-five one-hundredths (27.25) acres, known as the E. F. Hipp Place, in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Woodruff-Greenville Public Road, five (5) miles southeast from Greenville, on the waters of Laurel Creek and now in the possession of E. F. Hipp, bounded on the north by lands of A.J. Greer, A. J. Brown; on the east by lands of A. J. Brown, on the south by lands of John Green; on the west by lands of W. P. Connyers. Said tract of land is particularly described according to a plat prepared by W. A. Christopher Surveyor, on the 21st day of November, 1919, as follows, to-wit:
