All that tract or parcel of land containing forty-three and forty one-hundredths (43.40) acres in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the old Cox place, located on the Georgia Road, about two (2) miles from Simpsonville, on waters of Rocky Creek, now in the possession of W. S. G. Sweeney and bounded on the North by lands of Corrie Bramlett; on the East by lands of Corrie Bramlett; on the South by lands of R. L. Richardson; on the West by lands of B. E. Geer and G. C. Jones, and having the following courses and distances, according to survey and plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, July 7th, 1934, as follows, to-wit:-
