## AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That

WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of Thirteen Thousand and <sup>no</sup>/<sub>100</sub> 1300.00) \$ } Dollars, payable to the order of the second party,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, do make, seal, publish, and declare, that we have this day made and executed the foregoing instrument, in the presence of the witnesses, and in the city of New York.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released to these simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

Five days after the note  
and Bank of Columbia,  
the Federal Farm  
Land Bank of Congress, known  
as the Federal Farm  
Land Bank Agency and Attorney  
for the Federal Land  
Bank of Columbia,  
and before said mortgagee satisfied  
the Act of Congress, known  
as the Federal Farm  
Land Bank Act, or less, situated, lying  
South of Coal Ridge on the Enoree River, about twelve  
miles S. of Greenville, now in the possession  
of Chibald Mahaffey (John Chibald Mahaffey) bounded on the  
Colus Brook by the Enoree River, on the East by lands of  
this 27th day of October 1935, on the South by lands of the  
estate of J. B. Snow and the lands of D. F. Smith, on  
November the West by the lands of H. F. Smith fifth. Said land  
is particularly described according to a plat  
prepared by H. J. Kiddle Surveyor, dated November 21, 1935,  
now on file with the County Clerk, Greenville, South Carolina,
