Lying and being near the Old Easley Bridge Road, about four miles from the City of Greenville, S.C., and being known and designated as Tract No. 8 as shown on Plat made by Dalton & Neves, October 1932 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Saluda River and running thence N. 35-30 E. 126 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 22-0 E. 1264 feet to an iron pin in road; thence with said road as line N. 21-05 E. 708 feet to an iron pin in said road corner of Tract No. 7; thence with line of Tract No. 7, N. 46-30 W. 953 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-20 W. 1130 feet to Saluda River; thence down the meanders of said river to the beginning corner, and containing 41 acres, more or less. This being one of the tracts of land conveyed to me this day by Roy H. Bogeman as Receiver for the Bank of Commerce. This mortgage is a first lien on this tract of land.
