all that tract or lot of land in Black Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Near the town of Greer, S. C. and being known and designated as Lot No. 19 on a Plat of the property of Cannon Park, Plat of same being recorded in Plat Book 195, Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Snow Street at joint corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with joint line of said lots N. 22 E. 315.8 feet to point on a 15 foot alley, joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence along the Southern Boundary of said alley N. 76-30 W. 57 feet to joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence S. 22<sup>o</sup> 48' 306.2 feet along joint line of Lots Nos. 18 and 19 to a point on the Northern side of Snow Street; which point is the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence along the Northern line of Snow Street S. 68 E. 55 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same lot conveyed P. F. Lindsey to R. B. Jones on November 28, 1924, deed being recorded in Deed Book 98, page 298, R. M.
