sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Turner University, its
successors and assigns all our two-thirds undivided
interest in and to Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.*

*being known and designated as lots nos. 8 and 9 of
Section 29 as shown by a plat recorded in Plat Book
6, page 10, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, having
the following metes and bounds, to wit:*

*Beginning at a stake on the north side of White
Circle, joint corner with lots nos. 9 and 10, and running
thence N. 27^o 27' 273.5 feet to a stake, thence N. 64-30 E.
200 feet to a stake on Bradley Street, thence with
Bradley Street, S. 24 E. 244 feet to a stake at corner of
Bradley Street and White Circle, thence with said
White Circle in a westerly direction 222.6 feet to the
beginning corner, and being the same conveyed to L.
A. Turner by J. L. Thornhill, and the same land conveyed
to the mortgagors herein and William L. Thornhill by
deed from the Carolina Loan and Trust Company
