with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill, in hand well and truly paid by the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Dean S. Sherrill, his successors and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, on the South side of Beaufort Street, in Third One of the City of Greenville, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Beaufort Street at the corner of Mrs. Gilreath's lot and running thence along the line of Beaufort Street with 60 feet to a stake 3x, at the corner of a lot now or formerly belonging to Mrs. Latimer, thence along the line of said Latimer lot in a southerly direction one hundred thirty-eight (138) to a stake 3x; thence in a westerly direction sixty-seven (67) feet to corner of Mrs. Gilreath's lot, thence along the Gilreath line (46) forty-six feet to a wind in said line; thence along the balance of said line one hundred twenty-two (122) feet to the beginning corner on the south side of Beaufort Street, being the same lot conveyed by Mary J. Latimer to my father, Henry J. Stroud, on the January 1st, 1890, deed recorded in Vol. VII. at page 14, the said Henry J. Stroud having devised the property unto Maria Stroud for life and at her death unto Alice Fins and Nora Sherrill, the said Alice Fins having conveyed her interest unto me by deed of even date with this mortgage.
