SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Eula L. King and D. L. Kingin and by her certain of January

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont, a corporation  
fully chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina  
in the full and just sum of Three Hundred and 110/100 Dollars  
to be paid Six Months after datewith interest thereon from Januaryat the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of amount so collected  
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Eula L. King and D. L. Kingin consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better  
securing the payment thereof to the said Bank of Piedmontaccording to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum  
of Three Dollars, to me the said Eula L. King and D. L. King,  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank of Piedmontat and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Bank of Piedmont, a corporation, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated in Greenville County, State and County aforesaid, containing  
11.20 acres, and 20/100 (11.20) acre, south tract of land conveyed to the  
Eula L. King, by H. H. Bogeman Jr., his attorney for the Bank  
of Commerce, Greenville, S.C. by deed dated February 24, 1930 and  
recorded in office of H. M. C. for Greenville County on Feb. 13, 1930,  
at page 355. It includes all those parcels together with other parcels  
described and referred to said deed in foregoing Deed, having part  
of the 14. 11. broad lands in Greenville County, State of South Carolina  
filed, surveyor dated 1911. 24<sup>th</sup> 1934.  
etc., all that other piece, parcel or tract of land situated in  
Greenville County, State and County aforesaid, containing  
Twenty - seven and 96/100 (27.96) acres, more or less, and being  
the same tract of land conveyed to Mr. H. H. King, by H. H.  
Bogeman as trustee for the Bank of Commerce, Greenville  
S.C. by deed dated January 7<sup>th</sup> 1928 upon which the Bank of  
Piedmont took a first mortgage which is recorded in office of  
H. M. C. for Greenville County on Feb. 1928, at page 171.
