All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State, aforesaid, on the East side of East North Street in the City of Greenville, and having bearing and also situated as Lot No. 1 of the George Howard Subdivision as shown on plat made by W. M. Hart, Eng., May 1929, and bearing the following number and bearing, to - west:

"Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of East North Street, corner of lots 1 and 2, as shown on said plat, and running thence with the front line of said lots S. 49-02 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 41-04 E. 45.9 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 08-56 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the eastern line of East North Street; thence with East North Street as now located S. 41-02 W. 54 feet to the beginning corner."
