these presents, *and* well and truly indebted to *Jeff R. Phillips*in the full and just sum of *One Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00)*

to be paid *one year after date**10 months*with interest thereon from *date*

at the rate of *6* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *semi-annually*
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
 due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
 this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *five per cent*
 besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
 hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
 under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum
 of Three Dollars, to *J. H. Smith*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Jeff R. Phillips, his heirs and assigns;

all that certain lot or parcel of land, situate,
 lying and being in Greenville Township, County and
 State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known and
 designated as Lot #24 of the subdivision known as
 Augusta Circle as shown on plat of record in the
 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina,
 in Plat Book "5" page 23, and having according to
 said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of
 MacCormick Avenue, which iron pin is the joint corner
 of lots Nos. 23 and 24, and is 85.4 feet from the south
 east corner of MacCormick Avenue and East Augusta
 Street and running thence with the joint lines of lots
 Nos. 23 and 24, S. 71.36° E. 166.36 feet to an iron pin in
 line of Davenport property; thence with line of Davenport
 property S. 21.35° W. 50 feet to an iron pin, the joint
 corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25; thence with the joint
 line of said lots N. 71.35° W. 166.36 feet to an iron pin
 on the eastern side of MacCormick Avenue, thence with
 the eastern line of said avenue N. 21.35° E. 50 feet to
 an iron pin, the beginning corner.
