Whereas, the said *Sarah P. Gear*in and by *Mary* certain *two years ago*

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, *Am* well and truly indebted to *Piedmont Savings & First
Company*,in the full and just sum of *Eight hundred (\$800.00) Dollars*
to be paid two years after date, receiving the right to anticipate
repayment by said maker one year after date, said note
bearing in the sum of *Four hundred (\$400.00) Dollars each*,
with interest thereon from *date* *21st of May*at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *semi-annually*
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *\$100.00* *paid by the holder*
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That,

the said *Sarah P. Gear* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the said *Piedmont Savings & First Company*according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum
of Three Dollars, to *Mary* the said *Sarah P. Gear* *Piedmont Savings & First Company*in hand well and truly paid by the said *Piedmont Savings & First Company*
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Piedmont Savings & First Company,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with
the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the Fourth Ward of said City, on the
east side of South Main Street, and being known as
lot #1 as shown on a plan made by R. E. Galloway, Engineer
December 1914, and having the following lines, mates and bounds
to wit: *Beginning* at the Northwest corner of the stall of
property now owned by Beattie on the East side of Main
Street, and running thence with said street N. 19° E. 27 feet 6
inches to a corner on point, thence S. 73° 54' E. 56 feet 5 inches
to a point in line of lot no. 2, thence with line of lot no. 2,
S. 14° 33' 24" 5½ inches to a point in stall; thence S. 70° 05' E. 101
feet 2 inches to a point in said stall on Eastern line of lot #2;
thence with said line N. 17° 42' E. 8½ inches to a point on ten
foot alley; thence S. 70° 00' E. 10 feet 8½ inches across said
alley to a point in brick-wall; thence S. 14° 06' 24" 08 feet 1½
inches to a point on line of J. E. Serrine, thence with Serrine's
line N. 70° 52' 24" 44 feet 4½ inches to a point in line of
Beattie property; thence with said line N. 19° 05' E. 38 feet
8 inches to a corner of said Beattie property; thence again
with line of said Beattie property N. 70° 31' 24" 114 feet back
to the beginning corner. Together with the right to use the
eleven (11) foot alley extending East from the east corner of
said building to Main Street, said alley lying between
the property of G. C. Hindman and J. E. Serrine.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to Alvin
A. Gear by W. H. Chandler, as shown by deed dated June
24, 1920, and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds
Conveyance for Greenville County, in Vol. 68, page 209.
