SEND GREETING:

Whereas, *I* the said *A. R. Martin*in and by *me* certain *Promise*

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *C. F. Putman*

in the full and just sum of *Thirty five hundred and twenty five* Dollars
to be paid *as follows*: *Five hundred dollars is to be paid one*
year after date, and the balance two years after date

with interest thereon from *date*

at the rate of *7 1/2* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *Sevni - annually*
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *100%*
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *A. R. Martin*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the said *C. F. Putman*

of Three Dollars, to *me* the said *A. R. Martin*in hand well and truly paid by the said *A. R. Martin*

C. F. Putman at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

C. F. Putman, his heirs and assigns.

All that certain tract of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County,
State of South Carolina, containing 137.50 acres, more or less, as
shown on plat made by W. J. Riddle January 1927, and having the fol-
lowing lines and bounds according to said plat: Beginning at the
intersection of the Log Shoal Road and road leading to the Georgia
Road and running thence with Log Shoal Road N. 55 - 15' N. 449 feet to
a stake; thence continuing with said road N. 74 - 15' N. 320 feet; thence
continuing with said road N. 83 N. 1072 feet to a stake in said road;
thence S. 20 N. 185 feet to poplar in branch; thence down said branch as
a line 1035 feet to a stake; thence continuing down the branch as
a line 1893 feet to the mouth of the branch and Stoney Creek; thence
up said creek as a line 2484 feet to the road; thence up said
road N. 78. 72 feet to a bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 58 - 15' N. 175 feet to bend; thence continuing
with said road N. 337 feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 21 N. 339 feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 20 E. 724 feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 4 - 15 N. 340 feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 26 - 45 N. 114 feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road N. 46 - N. 482 feet to the beginning corner, and being
the same tract of land conveyed to me by E. P. Keller by his deed of
even date and not recorded.
