 following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in Buncombe Road, corner
 of School lot, and running thence S. 59° 21'. 403.6 feet to
 iron pin; thence S. 11.30 21' along church lot and tract no.
 9 to iron pin in line of tract no. 1; thence S. 60° E. 203.4
 feet to iron pin; thence S. 33° 21'. 168.2 feet to iron pin
 near branch; thence N. 70.30 E. 664.7 feet to iron pin;
 thence N. 59.30 E. 231.2 feet to iron pin in Buncombe
 Road; thence along said road N. 37.45 21'. 244 feet to bend
 in road; thence N. 40.45 21' along said road 432.6 feet
