SEND GREETING:

Whereas I, J. W. Collingham, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being of full age and of sound mind, do make and give on the 14th day of May, 1944, to my self, R. M. Stith, my seal, note in writing, of even date with these presents, and of the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) Dollars to be paid one year from the date hereof, and interest thereon at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Two and one-half cents besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, J. W. Collingham,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said M. J. Stith,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said J. W. Collingham,

in hand well and truly paid by the said M. J. Stith

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

M. J. Stith, his heirs and assigns, the following described property;

All that certain piece of land known as Lot No. 7, tract No. 3 of the original Overbrook Land Co. plat, said tract No. 3 known as Hillside Heights, said lot having the following lines and bounds. Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Circle Street, said point being the point corner of Lots No. 7 and 8 and running North 43-37 West one hundred and sixty-nine feet (169') to an iron pin, the point corner of Lots 8, 9 and 10; thence North 12-21 East twenty-five feet (25') to an iron pin; thence South 75-03 East one hundred eighty-four and six-tenths feet (184.6') to an iron pin on Circle Street; thence South 29-49 West sixty-four feet (64') along the North side of Circle Street to an iron pin at the point of beginning, said lot being situate in Greenville-Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
