covenanted and agreed between us on the 15th day of December 1928.

with interest thereon from the date of this note.

at the rate of six per cent per annum, to be computed and paid annually until paid in full; interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate of annual, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five per cent of principal due besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a debt hereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to myself and my heirs and assigns forever,

At and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

*R. L. Simmons*, his heirs and assigns forever: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Fork Shoals Road 3 X N m and running thence N. 25 1/4 W. with said road 6. 36 chs. to iron pin 3 X N m; thence N. 65 1/2 E. 16. 58 chs. to iron pin 3 X N m; thence S. 23 3/4 E. 1. 67 chs. to stone 3 X 0 m; thence S. 2 1/2 E. 9. 00 chs. to stake 3 X 0 m; thence S. 7 3/4 W. 9. 77 chs. to stone 3 X 0 m; thence S. 64 1/2 W. 4. 14 chs. to the beginning corner and adjoining land of Wm.
