 computed and paid monthly.

until in full all interest not paid when due to be interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
 principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee

Ten (10) per cent October 15, 1935, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
 added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
 be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as is and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will  
 more fully appear.

All those pieces, parcels, and lots of land lying and  
 being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just  
 beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville,  
 designated as lots nos. 22, 23 and 24 of the Hicks and  
 Jackson subdivision according to plat made by  
 R. E. Dalton, C. E., June 1920, recorded in R. M.C.  
 Office for Greenville County, South Carolina,  
 in Plat Book E. Page 258, and being more par-  
 ticularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe at the south  
 corner of Goodrich Avenue and Hillcrest Street,  
 corner of lot no. 24 and running thence south  
 46° 34' E. 87 feet along line of lots 24, 23 and 22,  
 to joint corner of lots nos 22 and 21; thence along  
 joint line of said lots nos 22 and 21, said line  
 running from Hillcrest Street to Cherry Avenue,  
 south 33° 39' West 140.3 feet to joint corner of  
 lots 22 and 21, lying on the north side of Cherry  
 Avenue; thence along line of lots 22, 23 and 24,  
 lying on Cherry Avenue, north 46° 41' West 63 feet  
 to iron pipe at corner of lot no. 24, said corner  
 being the north corner of Goodrich Avenue and  
 Cherry Avenue; thence north 33° 39' East 142.4 feet  
 along Goodrich Avenue to iron pipe on corner
