to be paid in monthly installments of \$600.00, and also a balance \$600.00 per
month, until paid in full, said E. R. Bell,¹⁵³⁴ shall have the option of anticipating all or part
of the balance due at any time, and shall have the privilege of increasing the monthly payments
at any time, the full balance so advanced to include interest and principal
with interest thereon from date of mortgage for months to include interest and principal
at the rate of ~~6~~¹² per cent per annum, to be computed and paid
until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent
