until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 5% of the amount due, besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in O'Neal Township County and State aforesaid about 12 miles from the City of Greenville on the west side of the Bunker Hill Road and having the following meets and bounds to wit:

Being that an iron pin on the Bunker Hill Road corner of tract of land known as the Henry Darby Tract and running thence about N. 30 W. with the Bunker Hill Road six hundred and fifty feet (650) more or less, to a cedar tree in line between my lands and the Thompson land which tree is about 650 feet from the beginning corner, thence with said dividing line six hundred and fifty feet (650) more or less the beginning corner, also all that other certain piece parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid adjoining the above described tract of land and having the following meets and bounds to wit:
