Whereas, I, the said J. L. Phillips,

SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain residence at 2118 o'clock in the month of August,

these presents, at this day well and truly indebted to J. H. Walter, Jr., for the sum of \$1000.00 Dollars to be paid at the rate of \$15.00 per month, interest to be paid on the first day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of principal, with interest thereon from date,

at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid monthly,

39 months

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$5.00, besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. L. Phillips,

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in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. H. Moody,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said J. L. Phillips,

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. H. Moody,

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. H. Moody, his heirs or assigns, forever;

"all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, about two miles west of the County Courthouse in a subdivision known as City View, and being described as follows:

"Beginning at an iron pin on Summit Street at a point 100 feet from the intersection of Summit and Hunt Streets, and running thence in a northerly direction 100 feet to an iron pin, thence in a southerly direction 28 feet to a stake; thence in a line across the rear portion of Lots 115 and 116 to a stake on Summit Street, wherein stake is approximately 60 feet from the intersection of Summit and Hunt Streets; thence with Summit street in an easterly direction 60 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same lot conveyed to me by my late husband, J. H. Moody, et al., by deed not yet recorded."
