Rolfe Ball, attorney, all of over undivided interest in and to all that said piece or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, containing nineteen acres, more or less, being known as lot no 4 of the subdivision of the Sanford Mathem tract, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone corner 3x0m, at corner lands M. B. Page and Pleasant Walker, running thence N. 75° E. 500 to a stone 34nm; thence N. 75° E. 6.50 to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 67° W. 11.00 to a stone 3x0m on an old road; thence with said old road 4.85 to a stone on road at Pleasant Walker's line, thence S. 33° W. 25.05 to the beginning corner. Being part of tract known as Sanford Mathem tract conveyed to us on October - 1892 by D. P. Yerkes Master, upon which my residence is now situate.
