AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

WHEREAS First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of ~~Eleven hundred and twenty (\$1100.00)~~ ~~(\$1100.00)~~ Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of ~~five (5%)~~ per centum per annum, the first payment of interest being due and payable on the ~~1st~~ day of ~~December~~, 193~~4~~, and thereafter interest being due and payable ~~annually~~; said principal sum being due and payable in ~~ten (10)~~ equal, successive, ~~annual~~ installments of ~~One hundred and thirty-one thousand one hundred and thirty-one (\$131,131)~~ ~~(\$131.00)~~ Dollars each, and a final installment of ~~one hundred and thirty-one thousand one hundred and thirty-one (\$131,131)~~ ~~(\$131.00)~~ Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the ~~1st~~ day of ~~November~~, 193~~8~~, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable ~~annually~~ until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

~~NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:~~

All that certain tract of land containing fifty-eight and
thirty-six one-hundredths (58.36) acres known as a portion
of the sixteenth land, in O'Neal Township, of Greenville County,
South Carolina, located on the public road leading from
Fairview Church to Silverthorn Hill, three miles northward
from Greer, on the water of Clear Creek, and now in the
possession of J. A. Talley bounded on the North by lands
of G. T. Beacham; on the East by lands of W. M. Bramlett;
L. Roy Bramlett and Middle Bramlett; on the South by lands
of D. M. Roshen and F. J. Osborne; and on the West by lands
of L. T. Beacham. Said tract of land is particularly describ-
ed according to a plat prepared by D. Brockman, Survey-
or, on the 7th day of September, 1933, and follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the road leading from Fairview
School to Silvatic Mill, the south eastern corner of said tract,
and running thence with said road North 13 degrees East
517 feet, to a stone; thence North 5 degrees East 712 feet to an
iron pin; thence North 4 degrees and 30 minutes East 870
feet to an iron pin; thence South 77 degrees and 25 minutes
West 278 feet to an ash; thence South 25 degrees and 5 min-
utes West 292.5 feet to a persimmon; thence South 4 degrees
and 25 minutes West 574 feet to a hickory; thence North
89 degrees East 228 feet to an iron pin; thence South
38 degrees and 30 minutes East 151.3 feet to poplar; thence
South 48 degrees and 15 minutes East 200 feet to a sweet
gum; thence South 80 degrees and 50 minutes East
458.5 feet to an iron pin; thence South 8 degrees and 15
minutes West 346.4 feet to an iron pin; thence South 75
degrees East 759 feet to the beginning corner.
