WHEREAS, I, the said R. N. Smith, in and by my certain person, on even date with these presents,

in the full and just sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, to be paid three years from date,

with interest thereon, from date of loan at eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid,

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to the interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. M. Jones,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Davis Mountain Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on head waters of branch and running thence S. 62° E. 4.86 chs to an iron pine, thence N. 77° E. 7.40 chs to an iron pine, thence N. 62° W. 17.8 chs to a stone, thence N. 67° W. 1.15 chs to a small pine, thence N. 63° W. 1.72 chs to a pine, thence N. 95° W. 3.85 chs to a stone, thence N. 83° W. 3.03 chs to a corner, blackjack, thence S. 10° E. 3.75 chs with Roe and Howard land; thence S. 82° W. 8.82 chs to a sweetgum on branch, thence with the meanders of the branch S. 9° E. 1.50 chs, thence with branch S. 16° E. 4.50 chs to the intersection of two branches, thence S. 92° W. 1.12 chs to a poplar, the beginning corner, and containing 20.45 acres more or less.
