besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Wm Goldsmith, as Guardian for Charles T. Davis*,

his successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on Circle Street in a subdivision known as Overbrook, and being known and designated as Lot no 162 on plat of said subdivision known as Plat no 4 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book 7, page 235, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Circle street at a point 142 feet from the intersection of Circle street and Overbrook Road, corner Lots 160 and 163, and running thence with rear lines of Lots 160 and 161 N. 71-13 E. 104 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot 163; thence with line of Lot no 163 S. 15-09 E. 45 feet to an iron pin in the right of way of Street car line; thence along the said right of way S. 60-20 W. 49.8 feet to an angle; thence still with said right of way S. 64-42 W. 50 feet to intersection of said right of way with Circle Street; thence with said Circle Street N. 02-16 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
