NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being situate in Butler Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, containing sixty-nine and fifty seven hundredths (69.57) acres, according to a plat and survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, July 3, 1933, and bounded on the North by lands of C. W. Smith, R. B. Taylor and J. E. Summey; on the East by the said J. E. Summey and W. R. Cox; on the South by J. E. Summey and W. R. Cox; and on the Westby J. A. Fowler's Eatate, Mrs. D. F. Smith and C. W. Smith; the said land is described by courses and distances upon the aferesaid plat as follows, to-wit:
