the first payment of interest being due and payable on the 15th day of November , 1934, and thereafter interest being
due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in equal, successive, annually
installments ofSeventy-five and no/100 (\$ 75.00) Dollars each, and a final install
ment of (\$) Dollars, the first installment of
said principal being due and payable on the 15th day of November, 193 8, and thereafter the remaining installments of
principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party his successors and assigns, the following described lands to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land containing Ninety-five and eighteen-hundredths (95.18) acres in Butler Township, of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Miller place, located on the Spartanburg-Woodruff Road 52 miles East of Greenville, bounded on the North by lands of J. D. Green and Mrs. C. E. Ballenger; on the East by lands of Mrs. C. E. Ballenger's Estate and Alex Finlay; on the South by lands of T. Garrett, T. Phillips and Mrs. O. K.
