NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that certain tract of land containing twenty-four and one-fourth (24/4) acres in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the new Buncombe Road and now in the possession of Lillian H. Snyder, bounded on the Northwest by lands of Mrs. Leila Davis; on the Northwest by lands of Mrs. Leila Davis and Hammond; on the Southwest by lands of Hammond; and bounded onthe Southeast by lands of Ward and United States Highway No. 25. Said tract of land is particularly described according to a plat prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., Surveyor, on the loth day of August 1933, and hath the following courses and distances, to-wit:
