(10-1-C-1) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the principal sum, with interest as herein provided, is paid, such payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal, and note where providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be unpaid and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the regulations of this mortgagor, the whole amount due under said note, and all the sum of the hold-over thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and for further protection for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of suit, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, off the sum so faced in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by attorney, or by legal process, by any kind (a) of which is secured under this mortgage, the amount by said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.
