Beginning at an iron pin on the Bunkcombe Road at corner of lot owned by Jesse Clyde Southerlin (above described), and running thence with the Bunkcombe Road N. $1\frac{1}{4}$ W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence $3.88\frac{1}{4}$ N. 212 feet to an iron pin, thence $81\frac{1}{4}$ E. 25 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Southerlin's lot; thence with Southerlin's line N. $88\frac{1}{4}$ E. 212 feet to the beginning corner.
