AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

H. L. Holloman

County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, first party is indebted to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, a corporation created, organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress, entitled the Federal Farm Loan Act, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of *Twenty-five Hundred and no/100* (\$2500.00) dollars,payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of *Ten (10%)* per centum per annum, (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress),the first payment on interest being due and payable on the *first* day of *January*, *1938*,and thereafter interest being due and payable *quarterly* annually; said principal sum being due and payable in*Seventy (70)* equal, successive, *annual installments*of *One Thousand five hundred and no/100* (\$1000.00) Dollars,each and a final installment of *(\\$)* Dollars, the first installment of said principal being dueand payable on the *first* day of *January*, *1938*

and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from the date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Brooks Road corner of ~~will~~ Griffin and running thence North 35 degrees East 740 feet to branch, thence with branch as the line, the following courses and distances, South 61 degrees 30 minutes East 100 feet, North 47 degrees East 100 feet, South 74 degrees East 21 feet 100 feet, North 47 degrees East 100 feet, South 74 degrees East 100 feet, North 81 degrees East 105 feet, South 74 degrees East 100 feet, South 74 degrees East 100 feet to a stone, thence North 20 degrees 30 minutes East 121 feet to a stake, thence North 37 degrees 15 minutes East 1184 feet to a stake, corner of W. A. Adams, thence with his line South 54 degrees 30 minutes East 1800 feet to rock, thence South 58 degrees East 726 feet to rock, thence South 4 degrees East 533 feet to rock, thence with E. G. Taylor's land South 77 degrees East 1430 feet to a rock, thence South 41 degrees East 324 feet to a rock, thence North 48 degrees East 846 feet to a rock, thence South 37 degrees 15 minutes East 267 feet to center of Brooks Road, thence with the center of said road as the line in a northeasterly direction a distance of 2238 feet to the point of beginning.
