until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
 principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
 and release unto the said S. M. Jones,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
 situate, lying and being on the north side of Stone
 Avenue, in Ward 1, of the City of Greenville, County and
 State aforesaid, designated as Lot no 13 as shown on
 plat made by R. E. Dalton, April 1919, and having
 the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at iron post at point corners of
 Lots nos 13 and 14 on Stone Avenue, and running
 thence with Stone Avenue N. 83.17 W. sixty feet to an
 iron post, thence N. 22.4 E. 166.5 feet to fence post;
 thence S. 84.09 E. 60 feet to corner of Lot no 14; thence
 with line of Lot no 14 S. 22.6 W. 169.5 feet to the
 beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed
