All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the sub-division known as Sans Souci Villas, represented on Plat of said Sans Souci Villa which is duly recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County as a part of Block C, and being designated as lot #29, and having the following lines and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe at the North west corner of Brockman Ave. and McCall St. and running thence along McCall St. N. 57.08 W. 221 feet and 1 inch to a stake at the North east corner of McCall St. and Franklin Road; thence along the easterly side of Franklin Road N. 32.52 E. 90 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 57.08 E. 183 feet and 6 inches to an iron pipe on the westerly side of Brockman Ave.; thence along the westerly side of Brockman Ave. about S. 10.15 W. 97 feet 7 inches to the beginning corner; this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Lattie C.
