WHEREAS, I, M. M. Bramlette, of Greenville, S.C., a citizen of the United States and a member of the National Bank of Greenville, do owe to Dobson Lumber Co., Inc., of Greenville, S.C., the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, being the principal amount of a note well and truly indebted to me by said Dobson Lumber Co., Inc., in the full and just sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, to be paid at my convenience, and interest thereon computed and paid in advance, at the rate of 10% per annum, from the date hereof until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and execute this mortgage; and note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, all to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, M. M. Bramlette, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Dobson Lumber Co., Inc.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, M. M. Bramlette, in hand well and truly paid by the said Dobson Lumber Co., Inc.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dobson Lumber Co., Inc.

All that piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in O'Neal Township near Fairview Church adjoining lands of R. B. Mason, T. Johnson and others, and having the following metes and bounds:- Beginning at stone and iron pin on Bank of Road 15 ft. Grishes from corner near center of Road (J. W. Salley's iron is 14 ft. 6 inches from corner near center of Road); thence with said road N. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 13.18 chains to iron pin R. B. Mason's corner; thence S. 75 E. 25.54 chains to stone; thence S. 2. 26. 9. 00 to stone; thence N 84 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 25.66 to the beginning corner, containing twenty-eight acres, more or less.
