Interest accrued up to date
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. of the amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said note, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

All that certain lot or parcel of land located near the City Limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the corner of lot no 3 on Burcombe Street, thence running S. 78 W. 203 feet to a stake; thence S. 13 1/2 E. 66 feet to corner of lot no 5; thence N. 78 E. 203 feet to Burcombe Street; thence with Burcombe Street S. 13 1/2 W. 66 feet to the beginning corners and being lot no 4 of Verner Land, plot made by W.
