computed and paid Semi-Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of

City of Greenville, at the North west intersection of Hampton
Ave. and Mulberry St. and having the following metes,

by R. E. Dalton Nov. 2, 1934. Beginning at a point at the
North west corner of Hampton Ave and Mulberry St., thence
along the west side of Hampton Ave. N. 31-40 W. 105 ft. to
an iron pin; thence along back line S 58-12 W. 50 ft.
to an iron pipe; thence along property of The Peoples
National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Executor of the Estate
