with interest thereon, from date at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five dollars,

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Mattie D. Croskeys,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, on Meaus Street, having the following metes and bounds: beginning at an iron pin on said Meaus St., (west side) about 52½ feet from the corner of Nichols St. and running north-easterly along Meaus St., forty-one and one half feet to old corner on my lot, thence along my old line, in a westerly or north-westerly direction seventy-five (75) feet more or less to iron pin on the old Logan line; thence in a south-westerly direction (parallel with Meaus St.,) forty (40) feet, more or less, to a stake; thence in a straight line seventy-five feet, more or less, to the beginning point on Meaus Street.
