On or before the 1st day of August 1935 with the said R. A. Stoddard or any of his heirs, assigns, administrators, executors, or assigns, at the place of payment

with interest thereon, from the date of the making hereof, at the rate of 3% per cent. per annum to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be in any way past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and enforce the same in any court of law or equity

and to close this mortgage, said note shall be provided for an attorney's fee of \$10.00, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.


