SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *J. H. Finley*, in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, *ann* (A. M. Dacus) well and truly indebted to *Sixty Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00)* Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*ten per cent.* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *J. H. Finley*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *R. M. Dacus*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *J. H. Finley*, the said *R. M. Dacus* in hand well and truly paid by the said *R. M. Dacus*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. M. Dacus*, his heirs and assigns

All that piece of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate about 2 1/2 miles from Greenville Court House on the north side of Finlay Bridge Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake 3X on back line 105 feet of 30 foot street and running thence S. 9 3/4 W. with line of lot No. 6, 210 feet to a stake 3X on Finlay Bridge Road thence along said road S 80 1/4 E. 105 feet to a stake 3X; thence N. 9 3/4 E. 210 feet to a stake 3X on back line; thence with said line 80 1/4 W. 105 feet to the beginning and being Lot No. 7, according to survey of J. N. Southern and being the same lot conveyed to me by Mary J. Coulledge, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 96, at Page 15.
