with interest thereon, from date Paid in full, at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid monthly, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Legal expenses, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

Mrs. J. R. Burdett, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Jas H. Stewart,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Mrs. J. R. Burdett

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. J. R. Burdett, All that certain piece of property in the Town of Greenville, located on the West side of Main Street, adjoining property the North by property occupied by Faughnside Lumber Co., Inc. the East by Main Street; on the South by another lot of Jas. H. Stewart; and on the West by the C. & W. C. Ry. right-of-way and known as the Jas H. Stewart's Tilling Station, having a frontage on Main Street of 83' and running in parallel lines to the C. & W. C. Right-of-way.

Also all that other lot of land adjoining the above described property, and having the dimensions of 33 1/3 feet on Main Street, and running in parallel lines to the C. & W. C. Ry. Right-of-way this being the same property conveyed to Jas H. Stewart by J. W. Stewart by deed dated Oct. 1st, 1931.
