All that piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being situate in Lumpkin Township, County and State aforesaid, being a portion of the estate of Ellen Cobb Shaw, containing 31 acres, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, made December 13, 1934.

Beginning at a point in the road running between lands of Maurice Stewart and Rose Cobb, running thence S. 56° 10' 20. 1650 feet to stake; thence 44-30 E. 577 feet to stake in blanch; thence N. 56-30 E. 1557 feet along line of lands of Rose Cobb and J.
