

## Mortgage.

To all whom these present may concern:

I, Thomas B. Williams, of Greenville, President  
hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send greetings:  
Whereas the mortgagor has well and truly  
indebted unto Eastley Bank of Eastley, South  
Carolina, a corporation organized and  
existing under the laws of the State of South  
Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as  
evidenced by a certain promissory note  
of even date herewith, the terms of which are  
incorporated herein by reference in the prin-  
cipal sum of Three Thousand Eight Hundred  
Dollars (\$3,800.00) with interest from the first  
day of July, 1936, at the rate of five per centum (5%)  
per annum until paid principal and inter-  
est being payable at the office of Eastley Bank, in  
Eastley, South Carolina, the monthly instalment  
of twenty-five and  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars (\$25.46) commencing  
on the first day of August, 1936, and on the first day  
of each month thereafter until the principal  
and interest are fully paid, except that the final  
payment of principal and interest to be paid sooner  
paid, shall be due and payable on the first day  
of January 1956.

I now know all men, that the mortgagor, in  
consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better  
securing the payment thereof to the mortgagee,  
and also in consideration of the further sum  
of Three Dollars (\$3) to the mortgagee in hand well and  
truly paid by the mortgagor at and before the  
reciting and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargain-  
ed, sold and released, by these presents does grant  
to mortgagee sell and release unto the mortgagee,  
its successors and assigns the following described  
real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State  
of South Carolina:

All that lot of land in the City of Greenville, County  
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the eastern  
side of East North Street, known as lot No. 1 as shown on  
plot of property of George Norwood, made by H. M. Cost  
in May, 1929, recorded in Plat Book "I", at page 277, and  
having the following metes and bounds: Beginning  
at an iron pipe on the east side of East North Street, corner  
of lots No. 1 and 2 as shown on said plot and running  
thence with joint line of said lots S. 49-02 E 200 feet to  
an iron pipe; thence N. 41-04 E. 45.9 feet to iron pipe;  
thence N. 48-56 W. 200 feet to iron pipe in eastern side  
of East North Street; thence with East North Street as now lo-  
cated S. 41-02 W. 54 feet to the beginning, and being the  
same lot conveyed to Thomas B. Williams by H. B. vault  
by deed dated April 2, 1935, and recorded in the R. M. C. of  
Greenville, South Carolina, in Book of Deeds  
180" at page 58."
