Helen B. McDaniel as Executrix under the will of W. C. McDaniel, deceased, in the full and just sum of Two Hundred and Fifty dollars.

Dollars, to be paid on or before one year from date

with interest thereon from date ~~annual after 1941~~, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceeding, then and in either of such cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Helen B. McDaniel, as Executrix under the will of W. C. McDaniel, deceased, her successors, heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 30 of the W. C. McDaniel property as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 186, and having according to a plat thereof prepared by L. M. Furrard Jr., C. E., May 22, 1930, the following

metes and bounds courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a point on the West side of McDaniel Avenue, which point is 212.4 feet in a northerly direction from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Lamelle Street and McDaniel Avenue, and running thence 789 degrees 0' N. 225.4 feet to an iron pin; thence 7.5 degrees 08' E. 209.66 feet to an iron pin; thence 863 degrees 02' E. 201 feet to an iron pin in the West side of McDaniel Avenue; thence along the Western side of McDaniel Avenue, 39 degrees 35' 34" 150.6 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to John S. Taylor by deed of W. C. McDaniel, dated February 27, 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 124, at page 350.
