SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Beattie B. Valentine

in and by my certain promissory note..... in writing, of even date with these presents, due Doris M. Hughes, as Guardian, in the full and just sum of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid on or before three years after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note....., after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note..... or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10..... per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, said by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Doris M. Hughes, as Guardian, the following described property, to wit:

I doe that certain piece, parcel or aliquot of land situate, lying and being on the Southeast corner of Earle and Rutherford Streets in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot #1 on a plat of M. E. Latimer's lot, made by W. D. Merri, Engineer, in July 1919, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast corner of property line of Earle and Rutherford Streets and running thence with a line of Rutherford St. S. 21° 10' W. 65 feet to an iron pin, corner of lots 1 and 2; thence with line on lot #2, S 85-15 E. 170 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot #4; thence with line of lot #4 N. 21° 10' E. 65 feet to an iron pin on Earle St.; thence with a line of said Earle St. S. 85-15 W. 170 feet to the beginning corner.
