WHEREAS, I, the said J. W. Sutherland, do hereby and do, in writing, of even date with these presents, make and sign a note in writing, of even date with these presents, in and by me, certain promissory note of sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) well and truly indebted to H. P. McGee and C. M. McGee as Trustees of the Estate of B. M. McGee, deceased, in the full and just sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) Dollars, to be paid on or before three years after date.

with interest thereon, from the date of issue at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being had thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. W. Sutherland, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Trustees, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. P. McGee and C. M. McGee as Trustees of the Estate of B. M. McGee, deceased.

All that tract or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 113 acres, more or less, on waters of Reedy River, bounded by lands of James J. Shumate, William Holland, and by Reedy River;

Beginning at an ash 3x on said river, and running thence S. 78 W. 58.50 to a stone 3x; thence S. 144 W. 4.33 to stone 3x on small branch; thence along meanders of said branch 58.95 to white Oak 3x, on branch of Reedy River; thence with said Reedy River to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to W.
